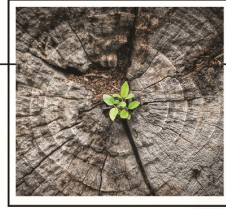

FAZtor's Notes

This weekend is the last two days of March. It is the fifth Sunday of the month but the church celebrates the Fourth Sunday of Lent which is called "Laetare Sunday" or "Rejoice Sunday." In the midst of our Lenten preparations, we are reminded of the joy that comes to us at Easter. Hence, on this Sunday, we look with expectation to the great Solemnity of Easter for which we have been preparing ourselves during the Lenten Season. By its anticipation of the joy of Easter, Laetare Sunday is meant to give us hope and encouragement as we slowly progress towards the Paschal Feast.

The celebration of Laetare Sunday is not just a celebration in the church. It should be celebrated at home to make it memorable. How? We look to some traditional observances and maybe some families are still holding them: a Sunday brunch with roses on the table would be appropriate. A family might also wish, during this beginning period of spring, to plant a rose bush on this day. Finally, there was a medieval tradition of visiting one's "mother church" (the church where one was baptized) on this day. A family trip to see where mom and dad or the children began their journey of faith could make for a fine Sunday afternoon outing!

Fifth Sundays usually occur 4 times each year and 5 times in every 5 or 6 years. This year we have 4 Fifth Sundays, 3/19, 6/30, 9/29 and 12/29. In our parish of Holy Name, the fifth Sundays are special days to support our Saint Vincent de Paul Society, dedicating our Second Collection to the cause of helping the poor and needy. While the group is in need of monetary support, they are also in need of people to join them in their mission. The current members are: Carol Maloof, John Murray, Edmund Swanson, Janet Potts and Maryellen Downey. We thank them for their noble work. When we have homeless and mentally challenged people knocking at our door asking for help, these people alternately come to talk to them and render the needed assistance. The group meets every Monday evening at 7:30 PM in the Meeting Room of our Pastoral Center. The meeting includes prayer and spiritual formation following the spirituality of St. Vincent de Paul, who was a French Catholic priest who dedicated himself to serving the poor. St. Vincent was renowned for his compassion, humility and generosity. He is also the Founder of Congregation of the Mission and Daughters of Charity of Saint Vincent de Paul. So, if you want to express your love for the poor, join our St. Vincent de Paul Society.

In other countries, eating apples is already a luxury as apples are regarded as fruit for the rich. In the United States, apples are the food often given to the homeless and the needy. If you like to eat bananas, monkeys like eating them too. Your worth is not based on what you eat or what you wear, but how you hear and obey God's words and follow his will.

隨著北半球春天的來臨，教會禮儀日歷中最大的慶節——慶節中的慶節——復活節也將隨之而來。按照普世教會目前仍然採用的額我略歷，復活節將會是每年春分（晝夜平分點）月圓之後的第一個主日。這樣，復活節雖然沒有一個固定的日期，但恰恰藉著陽光開始直射赤道並向北回歸線移動時，北半球進入了一個晝長夜短的時期，同時，也是一個由寒冷蕭瑟的冬季到溫暖和富有生機的春季的轉變。教會正以此季節和氣象的變化，來恰當地表達：基督永恒的光明戰勝了黑暗，為那「坐在黑暗和死影中的人們」（路1:79）帶來了希望和生命！今年的復活節將會是四月份的第三個主日——四月二十一日。

教會為了讓我們更深入地領悟基督的逾越奧跡（經過苦難進入復活的光榮），不但邀請我們以四十天的齋戒、祈禱和愛德的行動準備自己，而且特別藉著聖周的慶祝：從耶穌榮進耶路撒冷的聖枝主日開始，直到逾越節的三日慶典（聖周四主的晚餐、聖周五的基督苦難和聖死，聖周六基督在墓中的安眠，直到基督復活的凱旋），將基督「祂既然愛了世上屬於自己的人，就愛他們到底」（若13:1）的救恩行動，為我們完全展現出來。

因此，就讓我們以最虔誠的心和最充分的準備，參與教會為我們安排的每一項禮儀行動，好使我們真正能與基督同悲、同憂、同死、同埋，並能在基督無盡的慈悲和愛情裏，得以目睹基督為我們展現的整個救恩奧跡的完整圖像，分享與基督一起重生復活的喜樂！

預祝大家真正擁有一個喜樂、聖善的復活節！

Along with the arriving of the spring season in the north hemisphere, comes Easter--the greatest feast of the liturgical year in the Catholic Church. According to the Gregorian calendar, which is adopted as ecclesiastical calendar, Easter is dated on the first Sunday after the first Full Moon occurring after the March Equinox. Equinox is the time when the sun crosses the plane of the earth's equator and day and night are of equal length. After March Equinox, day time gets longer in north hemisphere, and winter is giving way to spring when nature shows its vitality. The Church uses this seasonal and climatic change to illustrate the victory of Christ as He has overcome death, brought life and hope to those who "dwell in darkness and the shadow of death" (Luke 1:79). The date of this coming Easter is on the 21st of April.

Our Mother Church invites us to enter into the paschal mystery of Christ, not only to prepare ourselves by fasting, praying, and loving, but also by providing a series of Holy Week liturgy (From Palm Sunday, to the Triduum: Last Supper on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, and the Easter Sunday), to reveal to us the salvific action of Jesus Christ who "having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end" (John 13:1).

Therefore, let us prepare ourselves to participate in every liturgy available to us, so that we can truly sorrow and die with Christ, and rise and rejoice with Christ. In His infinite mercy and love, we glimpse the blueprint of the salvific mystery accomplished.

Wish you all a very blessed and happy Easter!
