FAZtor's Notes:

Seems like Christmas was just yesterday. In a few days we will begin the Season of Lent with Ash Wednesday. We know that Lent, a period of prayer, penance and fasting in preparation for Easter, is 40 days long. The 40 days mirror Christ's fasting in

the desert before He began his public ministry. For those of you who are a bit meticulous with the 40 days, checking and counting your calendars, you will discover that there are actually 46 days before Easter. Why is that? Well, I don't want to bore you with its long history. The short answer is that Sundays are not included in the computation, since Sundays are meant to celebrate Christ's resurrection.

As Lent is a time for penance, cleaning our soul, fixing our life (like "Fixing the Broken Heart" as one song title goes), we are continuously trying to fix things that are broken on our property. We still have unresolved issues of pipes leaking in our Rectory and especially in one of our Church bathrooms. Resolving this is a quite complicated because we have to go through either the City or the Archdiocese. We ask for your understanding and patience and know that we have been trying hard to resolve this issue, although it is not quite in our control.

On the brighter side, we have fixed some of our broken kneelers in the church pews and a big thank you to **Mike Carr** and **Mike Gallagher** for voluntarily and patiently doing the hard work. **Mike Downing** has been helping us with replacing lightbulbs in the church ceiling and other immediate needs. The three Mikes have been our Three Kings these past few weeks, offering their stewardship of time, talent and resources to the church. Thank you Mikes!

Speaking of Mikes, our mics in the church are working so well now after we have updated the sound system. We have removed the broken mixer and replaced it with a new one that can be controlled with the use of an iPad or even a smart phone. We have also updated some of our old mics and the wireless communication system in the sound box. Yet, we are still in a period of fine-tuning everything. Again, we thank the "Father's Children-Magnificent 7" for sharing their talents to raise the money for this upgrade from the concert in November. We also thank **Carl Compton**, the sound technician, and parishioner **Art Howard** for pouring their hearts into this project.

Still on the happy side, we have replaced the old dilapidated Rectory garage door on the Lawton side with a new vinyl door that works quietly and flawlessly. Soon, we will be installing a new gate by the lower South stairs as you come up to the Church from the School yard to the Baptismal Font or the Blessed Virgin Mary Shrine.

There is still a lot to fix, including our hearts especially during Lent. So, I invite you to a free workshop by Fr. John Piderit on taking the Four Steps to make Stewardship your Way of Life. This could jumpstart your Lent as this is held right after Ash Wednesday on Saturday, February 29 and another session will be on March 21 from 1:00PM to 4:30PM in the Flanagan Center.

We fix our facilities, we fix our buildings, we fix our body and soul. Is there an "easy fix"? Probably! But the best fix is the "crucifix"! It is the greatest symbol of love.

The heart may stop beating but the Man on the Cross never stops loving – beyond – till death.

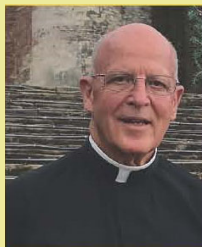

Father John Piderit, S.J., earned a Ph.D. in Economics from Princeton University, taught economics for twelve years at Fordham University, was president of Loyola University Chicago from 1993 to 2001, was president of the Catholic Education Institute from 2003 to 2018, and since 2014 has served as the Moderator of the Curia and the Vicar for Administration in the Archdiocese of San Francisco. The author or co-author of six books, he specializes in presenting the Catholic intellectual tradition in a way that teachers at the primary, secondary, or tertiary level can use to substantially improve academic results in their teaching.

Father Piderit is the Chief Operations Officer of the Archdiocese. Among his direct reporters is the Director of Stewardship, Florian Romero, his co-presenter. Ms. Romero was the President of a Filipino firm with annual revenues of \$25 million in the 1990s.
